

City of Cave Junction 2021 “No Spray” Program
Property Owner Annual Agreement

The City of Cave Junction is required to maintain its’ right-of-way to sustain road health and to remain in compliance with regulation set by the Oregon Department of Agriculture, Oregon Department of Forestry Wildfire Protection Plan and Cave Junction Municipal Code 8.08.090.

The City of Cave Junction recognizes and empowers property owners to participate in roadside maintenance by offering an op-out program or “No Spray” process which allows them to maintain roadsides that fall within their personal property lines. Property owners who wish to participate in this program must agree to comply by completing the following application and by acknowledging their understanding of this program.

I, _____(print name) do hereby declare that I am the owner of the property located at (address) _____ in the City of Cave Junction, and that I hereby agree to comply with this agreement and the CONDITIONS required to participate in the “No Spray” program.

Sign Placement:

- No later than **APRIL 11, 2021** place signs, provided by the City at the beginning of the right-of-way line that falls inside your property lines in a clearly visible location (fence post, secured stake or some other solid object.) Trees, buildings, mailboxes, city street signs and utility poles ARE NOT ACCEPTABLE objects for posting signs.
- Place the RED sign at the beginning of your property line and the GREEN sign at the end of the area that falls within your personal property line. The sprayer will be traveling with traffic on the right side of the road. The edge of your property that is approached first is considered the beginning and is where the RED sign is placed. This will delineate the area to be exempt from spraying.
- If you and your neighbor have adjacent areas that are not to be sprayed, ensure that the signs are coordinated and installed as a continuous area to prevent confusion.

Vegetation Management Required:

- Maintain designated roadsides between May 1 to September 30 or any other time if designated fire hazards are extended past September 30th.
- Areas 4’ to 6’ from roadways that fall within your designated “No Spray” area must be cleared of all vegetation. Maintenance beyond the 6’ area must be maintained in accordance with MC 08.08.090.

Failure to Maintain:

- Failure to follow maintenance standards to the City’s satisfaction may cause the City to exercise its right to:
 - 1) Spray the right-of-way with herbicide; and
 - 2) Perform the necessary vegetation management; and
 - 3) Terminate this agreement. Terminated agreements will disqualify applicant from applying to future “No Spray” options.
- Any liability for fire which occurs in a right-of-way that is designated as a “No Spray” zone will fall to the property owner.
